TASTING NOTES

All things are not as they seem: A dark, demonstrative red blend of unmistakable quality, the Indie Riot is a perfect fit for any night of the week. Pair this opulent, Paso Robles born wine with a steak dinner among friends; or with a couch, blanket, and your favorite book. There is no wrong time or place to enjoy a Riot! Savory bacon fat on the nose along with rich notes of dark chocolate and reduced boysenberries hit you like a punch in the face while subtle notes of vanilla and black cardamom. A silky entry with flavors of sweet anise opens into a firm mid-palate laced with flavors of blackberry jam, tobacco, and dried figs. Firm tannins lengthen the fresh flavors of the wine well into the finish, begging to be enjoyed again.

VINIFICATION

Fermented in a combination of stainless steel tanks and 1 ton bins, fermentations varied between 16-25 days for rich extraction of color and tannin. Pressing was done by a combination of Bladder pressing and basket pressing, depending on the variety.

AGING

Aged for 9 months in French Oak barrels with about 15% being new French oak.
